Roman Mosaic

What you'll need

- Card or paper
- Coloured pens, crayons, pencils, or coloured paper/tissue paper
- Glue
- Scissors



What you need to do:

Either:

1. Print out the template on the next page and colour in the squares

Or:

2. Make your own mosaic by scrunching up tissue paper or cutting out small bits of coloured paper and sticking them onto some card, making a pretty picture like our examples.

Mosaics were symbols of wealth and status. Blending art and home décor, Roman mosaics were commissioned to adorn and impress guests inside private homes and villas.

Today mosaics are still a popular art form. They can be used in kitchen backsplashes, craft projects, garden art, as fine art, sculptures, park benches and also in public art.
